Members of Science '06 will host alumni for a pancake breakfast at 224 Earl Street (near Barrie). We have assured the organizers that Science '79 will have a large turn out and the students are looking forward to it. Be sure to attend.

The first Science 79 Magic Bus to the breakfast will leave the Peachtree hotel at 8:45 am sharp and will then stop at the Sheraton Four Points (9 am estimated) and then proceed to the pancake breakfast at 224 Earl Street. The Magic Bus will then return to the Peachtree and make one more stop at the Sheraton Four Points (9:45 estimate). The Magic Bus will then return the Peachtree and drive any additional classmates on an as needed basis to the pancake breakfast.

Pancakes and juice will be served at the breakfast. If you want anything else (coffee?) it might be an idea to grab something at the hotel beforehand.
